Along with this, he also conveyed his best wishes to all, suggesting that the officers and employees of other speaking category should be prepared at par with the Hindi speaking category by motivating and encouraging them more.

CMD, Commodore Siddharth Mishra (Retd.) in his address, congratulated the cash awardees of the competitions organized during the Hindi Fortnight and the incentive scheme beneficiaries and said that right from our freedom struggle, 'Swaraj', 'Swadeshi' and 'Swabhasha' have been our basic motives. Also, they have been receiving awards consequently by participating in competitions at Organization level and at inter-PSU level.

Congratulating all the member offices and officers and employees for their contribution for the Rajbhasha Kirti Award received for the work of TOLIC (U) for

the period 2019-20, he appealed everyone to maintain and raise the performance to the next level.
